21-Day Fast: 3/4 - 3/24

The Holy Spirit, often referred to as the third person of the Trinity, is one of the three distinct (functions, personalities, persons) of the Godhead, alongside the Father and the Son (Jesus Christ). The Holy Spirit is often described as the active presence of God in the world and in the lives of believers.

The Holy Spirit is ESSENTIAL and NECESSARY in:

1. **Personal Empowerment:** The Holy Spirit empowers believers to live out their faith, enabling them to overcome obstacles, resist temptation, and bear witness to Christ (Acts 1:8).

2. **Guidance:** The Holy Spirit guides believers into truth, illuminating Scripture, providing wisdom, and directing their paths (John 16:13, Romans 8:14).

3. **Regeneration:** The Holy Spirit brings about spiritual rebirth, transforming believers from the inside out and giving them new life in Christ (Titus 3:5).

4. **Sanctification:** The Holy Spirit sanctifies believers, conforming them to the image of Christ, and empowering them to live holy and righteous lives (2 Thessalonians 2:13, Romans 8:13).

5. **Intercession:** The Holy Spirit intercedes for believers in prayer, communicating their needs and desires to God when they don't know how to express them (Romans 8:26-27).

6. **Unity:** The Holy Spirit unites believers into one body, the Church, regardless of differences in background, culture, or ethnicity (1 Corinthians 12:13, Ephesians 4:3).

7. **Fruitfulness:** The Holy Spirit produces fruit in the lives of believers, such as love, joy, peace, patience, kindness,

goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23).

8. **Empowerment for ministry:** The Holy Spirit equips believers with spiritual gifts for ministry, enabling them to serve and build up the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:4-11).

9. **Conviction:** The Holy Spirit convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, drawing people to repentance and faith in Christ (John 16:8-11).

10. **Seal and Guarantee:** The Holy Spirit seals believers as God's own and guarantees their inheritance in Christ, providing assurance of salvation (Ephesians 1:13-14, 2 Corinthians 1:22).

Overall, the Holy Spirit's role is essential in every aspect of the Christian or "CHRIST-LIKE" life, from salvation and sanctification to guidance and empowerment for ministry. He is the active presence of God in the lives of believers, enabling them to live faithfully and fruitfully according to God's purposes.

In this 30-Day devotion, it is our goal as a church to become reacquainted with the person, presence and power of the Holy Ghost in a more meaningful and deeper way than we ever have. Let's allow the Holy Spirit to permeate every part and sector of our lives so that we can experience the "OVERCOMING" and "OVERFLOWING" power He gives to live an overcoming and "VICTORIOUS" life in this world.

The Holy Spirit was given to us by God to convict, correct, lead and guide us in our spiritual walk. Jesus conquered sin, death, hell and the grave on the cross; however, because we have a free-will; that will can often lead us astray and into sin and disobedience. In order to maintain a life of purification and sanctification on a daily basis; we need the indwelling presence and nature of God inside of us. The Holy Spirit does this work on the inside of us. He enforces the WORD and WILL of the Father here on the earth. Romans 8 clearly states the freedom we receive through the Holy Spirit, enabling us to live free from sin and its separation from God.

Romans 8:1-14 (KJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

³ For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

⁴ That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

⁵ For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

⁶ For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

⁷ Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

⁸ So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

CONFESSSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit empowers me to overcome sin and live victoriously in Christ. I confess that the Holy Spirit convicts me of sin and leads me to repentance and restoration. Today, I invite the Holy Spirit to cleanse and purify my heart, making me holy and blameless before God. Today, I acknowledge the Holy Spirit’s presence in my life, guiding me into deeper intimacy with God.”

Day 1: Monday - March 4, 2024 - The Presence of the Holy Spirit!

CONFESSION: “Today, I open my heart to receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit’s power and presence.”

Reflect on the purpose/promise of Jesus to send the Holy Spirit (John 14:16-17). ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **advocate/ (comforter)** to help you and be with you forever— ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be^[a] in you

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to make His presence known to you throughout this devotion.

Day 2: Tuesday – March 5, 2024 - The Comforter – (parakletos) “intecessor”; “consoler”; “helper”!

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit intercedes for me according to the will of God, even when I don’t know how to pray. Today, I declare that the Holy Spirit brings comfort and strength in times of trouble and uncertainty.”

Meditate on the role of the Holy Spirit as the Comforter (John 14:26). ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **advocate/ (comforter)** to help you and be with you forever.

Prayer: Seek comfort and strength from the Holy Spirit in any challenges you’re facing.

Day 3: Wednesday – March 6, 2024 - The Spirit of Truth!

CONFESSION: “Today, I confess that the Holy Spirit is my constant companion, guiding me in truth and righteousness.”

Contemplate the Holy Spirit’s role in guiding you into all truth (John 16:13). ¹³ But when He, the Spirit of Truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth [full and complete truth]. For He will not speak on His own initiative, but He will speak whatever He hears [from the Father—the message regarding the Son], and He will disclose to you what is to come [in the future].(AMP)

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you into deeper understanding of God’s truth.

Day 4: Thursday – March 7, 2024 - Fruit of the Spirit!

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit fills me with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.”

Reflect on the fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control (Galatians 5:22-23). ²² But the fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us] is love [unselfish concern for others], joy, [inner] peace, patience [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Prayer: Pray for the Holy Spirit to cultivate these fruits in your life.

Day 5: Friday – March 8, 2024 - Baptism of the Holy Spirit!

CONFESSION: “Today I invite the Holy Spirit to dwell within me, fully immersing me in His presence and power. I surrender afresh to the Holy Spirit’s control, allowing Him to have His way in me. I declare that the Holy Spirit empowers me to be a bold and effective witness for Jesus Christ.”

Consider the baptism of the Holy Spirit and its empowerment for ministry (Acts 1:8). ⁸ But you will receive power *and* ability when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be My witnesses [to tell people about Me] both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth.”

Prayer: Seek a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit’s power for your life and service.

Day 6: SATURDAY – March 9, 2024 - Gifts of the Spirit!

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit equips me with spiritual gifts to serve others and build up the body of Christ. I confess that the Holy Spirit empowers me to live a life of sacrificial love and service to others.”

Explore the spiritual gifts given by the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:4-11).

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal and activate your spiritual gifts for the benefit of the Church.

Day 7: SUNDAY – March 10, 2024 - Walking in the Spirit!

CONFESSION: “Today, I thank the Holy Spirit for His faithfulness and presence, guiding me each step of the way. Today, I will allow the Holy Spirit to order my steps and direct my path, leading me in a way that is pleasing and that honors Him.”

Reflect on what it means to walk in the Spirit and not gratify the desires of the flesh (Galatians 5:16). ¹⁶ I advise you to obey only the Holy Spirit’s instructions. He will tell you where to go and what to do, and then you won’t always be doing the wrong things your evil nature wants you to. (TLB)

Prayer: Pray for the Holy Spirit’s guidance in living a life pleasing to God.

Day 8: Monday – March 11, 2024 - The Intercessor

CONFESSION: “Today, I confess that the Holy Spirit intercedes for me according to the will of God, even when I don’t know how to pray.” HE KNOWS WHAT 2 SAY 4 ME!

Meditate on the Holy Spirit’s role as our intercessor in prayer (Romans 8:26). ²⁶ Likewise, the Spirit helps us in our weaknesses, for we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.

Prayer: Invite the Holy Spirit to intercede for you in areas where you don’t know how to pray.

Day 9: Tuesday – March 12, 2024 - Unity of the Spirit!

CONFESSION: “I declare that the Holy Spirit brings unity and harmony in my everyday relationships and in the Church.”

Reflect on the call to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Ephesians 4:3).³ Make every effort to keep the oneness of the Spirit in the bond of peace [each individual working together to make the whole successful].(AMP)

Prayer: Pray for unity and harmony in your relationships, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Day 10: Wednesday – March 13, 2024 - Renewal and Transformation!

CONFESSION: “I declare that the Holy Spirit is at work within me, transforming me from glory to glory. I acknowledge the Holy Spirit’s presence in my life, guiding me into deeper intimacy with God. I confess that the Holy Spirit renews my mind and transforms my heart, making me more like Jesus. I also, acknowledge the Holy Spirit’s role in bringing revival and renewal to my life and to the Church.”

Consider the Holy Spirit’s work in renewing and transforming your mind (Romans 12:2).

Prayer: Surrender your mind to the Holy Spirit’s transformative work.

Day 11: Thursday – March 14, 2024 - Overflowing with Hope!

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit fills me with hope and joy, even in the midst of trials and challenges.”

Meditate on how the Holy Spirit fills believers with hope (Romans 15:13). ¹³ May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will abound in hope *and* overflow with confidence in His promises.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with hope and joy, even in difficult circumstances.

Day 12: Friday – March 15, 2024 - Discerning the Spirits!

CONFESSION: “I declare that the Holy Spirit gives me discernment to recognize truth from falsehood and to walk in wisdom.”

Reflect on the importance of discerning the spirits (1 John 4:1). Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. **Ezekiel 44:23:** And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

Prayer: Pray for the gift of discernment to recognize the Holy Spirit's leading.

Day 13: Saturday – March 16, 2024 - Empowered Witness!

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit is at work in me, producing fruit that brings glory to God and blessing to others. I declare that the Holy Spirit fills me with boldness and confidence to proclaim the Gospel to the world.”

Consider the Holy Spirit’s empowerment for bold and effective witness (Acts 4:31). ³¹ And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to empower you to boldly share the Gospel.

Day 14: Sunday – March 17, 2024 - Revival and Renewal!

CONFESSION: “I declare that the Holy Spirit equips me with everything I need to fulfill God’s purpose for my life.

Meditate on the Holy Spirit’s role in bringing revival and renewal to individuals and communities (Acts 2:17-18). ¹⁷ And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:¹⁸ And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

Prayer: Pray for revival in your own heart and in the Church, led by the Holy Spirit.

Day 15: Monday – March 18, 2024 - Surrender and Yielding!

Day 26: Friday – March 29, 2024 - Overflowing with Hope! (GOOD FRIDAY)

Meditate on how the Holy Spirit fills believers with hope (Romans 15:13). ¹³ May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will abound in hope *and* overflow with confidence in His promises.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with hope and joy, even in difficult circumstances.

Day 27: Saturday – March 30, 2024 - Discerning the Spirits!

CONFESSION: “I declare that the Holy Spirit gives me discernment to recognize truth from falsehood and to walk in wisdom. I am not ignorant to satan and his devices (2.Cor.2:11)

Reflect on the importance of discerning the spirits (1 John 4:1). Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. **Ezekiel 44:23:** And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

Prayer: Pray for the gift of discernment to recognize the Holy Spirit’s leading.

Day 28: SUNDAY – March 31, 2024 - Empowered Witness! (EASTER – RESURRECTION DAY)

CONFESSION: “I confess that the Holy Spirit is at work in me, producing fruit that brings glory to God and blessing to others. I declare that the Holy Spirit fills me with boldness and confidence to proclaim the Gospel to the world.”

Consider the Holy Spirit’s empowerment for bold and effective witness (Acts 4:31). ³¹ And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and

they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to empower you to boldly share the Gospel.

Day 29: Monday – April 1, 2024 - Revival and Renewal!

Meditate on the Holy Spirit’s role in bringing revival and renewal to individuals and communities (Acts 2:17-18). ¹⁷ And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:¹⁸ And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

Prayer: Pray for revival in your own heart and in the Church, led by the Holy Spirit.

Day 30: Tuesday – April 2, 2024 - Surrender and Yielding!

CONFESSION: “Today, I surrender afresh to the Holy Spirit’s control, allowing Him to have His way in me. Today, I yield to the Holy Spirit’s leading, trusting His direction in every area of my life. I want the Holy Spirit to lead me into deeper intimacy with God, revealing His heart and His will.”

Reflect on the importance of surrendering to the Holy Spirit's control (Romans 8:5). ⁵ For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Prayer: Surrender every area of your life to the Holy Spirit's leading.

TYPES OF FASTS

DANIEL FAST

Refrain from consuming animal products, sugar, alcohol, caffeine, and refined or processed foods. Eat vegetables, whole grains, fruits, legumes, unleavened bread, and oils.

COMPLETE FAST

In this type of fast, you drink only liquids, typically water with light juices as an option. Drink only liquids (you establish the number of days).

SOCIAL MEDIA FAST

Refrain from using social media during the 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting.

PARTIAL FAST

This fast is sometimes called the "Jewish Fast" and involves abstaining from eating any type of food in the morning and afternoon. This can either correlate to specific times of the day, such as 6:00 am to 3:00 pm, or from sunup to sundown.

The Daniel's fast, typically focuses on consuming plant-based foods while abstaining from meat, dairy, sweets, processed foods,

and refined grains. Here's a list of foods commonly eaten during Daniel's fast:

1. Fruits: Apples, bananas, oranges, berries, grapes, kiwi, mangoes, pears, etc.
2. Vegetables: Leafy greens (spinach, kale, lettuce), carrots, cucumbers, bell peppers, broccoli, cauliflower, tomatoes, onions, garlic, etc.
3. Legumes: Lentils, chickpeas, black beans, kidney beans, peas, etc.
4. Whole grains: Brown rice, quinoa, barley, oats, whole wheat pasta, whole grain bread, etc.
5. Nuts and seeds: Almonds, walnuts, cashews, peanuts, chia seeds, flaxseeds, sunflower seeds, etc.
6. Plant-based protein sources: Tofu, tempeh, seitan, plant-based protein powders, etc.
7. Healthy fats: Avocado, olive oil, coconut oil, flaxseed oil, etc.
8. Herbs and spices: Basil, oregano, thyme, rosemary, turmeric, cumin, cinnamon, etc.
